WHEREAS, just as LARRY loved the Food Bank and was passionate about serving its clients, he was equally passionate about serving those in need in Haiti where he helped construct medical facilities and in Vietnam, where he had once witnessed the havoc of war, he returned with brothers-in-arms to deliver wheel chairs to the children of Vietnam; and

WHEREAS, LARRY found joy in serving and attending to the needs of his fellow human beings; and

WHEREAS, through his service and love, LARRY BAILLY contributed to making the Snohomish Community Food Bank a warm and welcoming place for its clients, **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT RESOLVED, LARRY ARNOLD BAILLY is hereby elected to the position of Honorary Member of the Board of Directors of the Snohomish Community Food Bank and his election shall be entered upon the permanent corporate records of the Food Bank.
